Dr. Samir Sinha

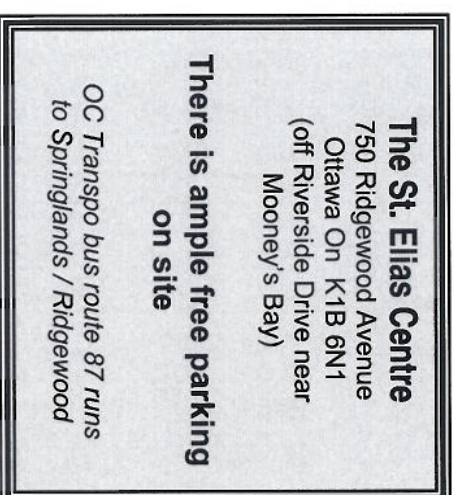
